

- Re-Charge from Walsh's to British Gas The Treasurer would send the invoice and detailed breakdown to the Chairman.
- HS2 Route Several members had attended a meeting held by the government in this connection, and it was reported that an engineer at this meeting had said that the alternative route put forward by Church Fenton pressure group had already been considered and turned down during the initial feasibility studies.. It was nevertheless decided that the Parish Council would object formally to the proposal, and the contact was Rachel Blake.
