Apologies for Absence

Received from Cllr. Mrs. Hodgson Cllr. Mr. Denison did not attend the meeting and no apology had been received.

Minutes of the Previous Meeting

These were signed as a true record, by a majority of three Councillors to one against. Cllr. Ms Barrowman insisted that her objection be Minuted in detail, and her written statement is attached, as is the Clerk's response to her questions

Matters Arising from the Minutes

Formal ratification of decisions taken between meetings; these decisions were recorded, but would now be formally ratified for the avoidance of doubt : the Chairman explained that it was sometimes necessary that decisions be taken between Parish Council meetings, and that where this was necessary, such decisions would be ratified at the meeting following.

- Objection to the application by North Yorkshire County Council to erect a prefabricated classroom unit (PCU) on the school playing field, on grounds of development in green belt, outside development area, in conservation area and next to Grade I listed building: Cllr. Ms Marshall proposed and Cllr. Mr Wilson seconded that this decision be formally ratified
- To engage the services of a planning consultant to assist in the opposition to the above application, said consultant to work with the pressure group known as "Save Saxton's Green Belt" a budget of £1400 was agreed : Cllr. Ms Marshall proposed and Cllr. Mr Wilson seconded that this decision be formally ratified
- To appoint Cllr. Ms Marshall onto the above group as the Parish Council representative, to ensure that the interests of the Parish Council are being met : Cllr. Ms Marshall proposed and Cllr. Mr Wilson seconded that this decision be formally ratified
- To defer further involvement in the speed ramp to the road in Silver Street : Cllr. Ms Marshall proposed and Cllr. Mr Wilson seconded that this decision be formally ratified
- To return the £5000 contribution made by Saxton Church of England School towards the cost of the ramp to ensure impartiality : Cllr. Ms Marshall proposed and Cllr. Mr Wilson seconded that this decision be formally ratified

Financial contributions from three members of SSGB

- £400 in total had been received, as an earnest of their commitment, for which the Parish Council thanked the donors.

There were objections both from the floor and from Cllr. Ms Barrowman, but the Chairman required that the meeting move forward
