

- Christmas Lighting The Chairman volunteered to liaise with the vicar over this.
- Trees in Dam Lane Reported to be Interfering with Power lines In the first instance, the Clerk was instructed to contact the power company.
- Request from Mrs Patton for work to tree in Main Street The Clerk was instructed to have a tree surgeon inspect this tree, and to report to the next meeting.
- Play Area at Saxton Village Green – letter from S.D.C. The Clerk was instructed to reply to the District Council advising that the Parish Council could see no necessity for a lease, though we do and will continue to undertake both maintenance and insurance for the playground. Policy documentation is available if required.
- School bin store The school secretary, Mandy Frith, outlined the difficulties the school is having over their refuse collection, inasmuch as the contractors are unwilling to take the 2 No. 660 litre heavy bins down the steps to Dam Lane. One possible solution suggested was the construction of permanent bin store sited on Dam Lane close to where the grit bin now is. The PC Clerk was asked to follow the matter up with Selby District Council in the first instance.
- Such other business as, in the opinion of the Chairman, should, by means of special circumstances, be considered as a matter of urgency For information, Cllr. Ms Marshall reminded the meeting that a Parish Council does not have flood prevention powers, only drainage powers. She went on to outline the work that had already been undertaken, and pointed out that we were now awaiting input from the department of Nigel Adams, our M.P., as per his assistant's attendance at the previous meeting.
