- Our County Councillor, Andrew Lee, had telephoned the Clerk to suggest a daytime meeting during the forthcoming week, in order that the flooding situation could be discussed during daylight. Thursday morning was chosen, and the Clerk would telephone Mr. Lee the next day.
- There had been a great increase in the incidence of fly tipping; the Clerk was instructed to request Selby District Council to provide a litter bin in the lay-by on the B.1217 opposite the Crooked Billet, though only if any such bin would be regularly emptied.
