Minutes of the Previous Meeting These were signed as a true record.

Matters Arising To receive Chair's report on quotations sought with regard to, and to decide upon, future drainage work in the village – the Chair was still awaiting quotations, and would continue to chase, though he had made progress in that he had made contact with Blakeys.

To receive Clerk's report over progress re registration of the Woodland Walk as a village green – an email from the solicitor to Cllr. Ms Marshall had gone astray, which communication had requested a meeting with Ms Marshall and Mr. Scriven, a long-term resident in the village. This was now being pursued. Also, the Chairman pointed out that the request for village green registration included the land all the way to the school entrance.

To receive Chair's further remarks over response by Cricket Club to donation conditions – nothing further had been heard from the Club, and the Chairman pointed out that the cricket season was coming to an end.

To receive report from Cllr. Mr. Westmoreland over street lighting – Mr. Westmoreland in his email apologising that he was unable to attend this meeting had also advised that Northern Powergrid had been made aware of the request for two new lampposts, and that he was still chasing Paul Ward for a quotation for the work reported earlier.

To receive further report on long-standing council tax mistake in connection with Lakeside Approach – Cllr. Richard Musgrave is pursuing this on our behalf, and in his absence there was nothing further to report.

To receive further information from Cllr. Andrew Lee regarding both funding assistance over flooding and probable increased traffic through Saxton resulting from expansion of Church Fenton airport – Cllr. Lee arrived later in the meeting, and his comments are Minuted under Public Forum
