

Report from Cllr.  
Andrew Lee

Our County Councillor, Andrew Lee, offered Richard Musgrave's apologies for absence, and advised that Mr. Musgrave, our District Councillor, was still following up the question of the long-standing council tax mistake.

In response to an enquiry over the "20's Plenty" signs in Barkston Ash, Cllr. Lee advised that they were illegal and those not on private land had been removed. Discussion regarding the speeding problem in Saxton resulted in a suggestion from him that the junction of Dam Lane and the B.1217 Wakefield Road be stopped, and this suggestion being wholeheartedly welcomed, Cllr. Lee promised to follow it up.

Cllr. Lee reported that he had made no further progress regarding the requested financial assistance for drainage work to Saxton, but would continue to chase.

Planning in the Parish

- a. Proposed single storey side extension and increase of eaves and ridge level over existing side garage to form room with pitched roof dormers to front at 1 Saxton Court, Saxton – the Parish Council had no objection to this.
- b. Proposed alterations to garage to provide additional ancillary living accommodation and office at Rose Dene – the Parish Council had no objection, but there was concern over the Portakabin still in place in the garden, and the Clerk was instructed to bring this to the notice of the District Council, and to ask that the enforcement notice for its removal be acted upon and not set aside to accommodate this application, also to copy the letter to Amanda Oakley, a neighbour of the applicant, who had expressed concern.
