

Concern was raised at the proposal to close off the junction of Dam Lane and the B.1217, but on balance it was felt that this was a good thing.

Planning in the Parish

- a. Proposed erection of a new dwelling at Saxon Holme, Coldhill Lane, Saxton – the Chairman précised the current situation, that permission had been erroneously given for a previous application, and that the applicant had confirmed that if this current application was refused, the first one would be built. It was accepted that of the two, the current application was preferable. The Clerk was therefore to write to the District Council as diplomatically as possible to make them aware of the problem, and at the same time to request that the materials used be in accordance with those already in use in the village – natural limestone with natural slate or clay pantiles, and that timber window frames be substituted for the presently proposed powder coated aluminium frames. The letter would be copied to Cllrs. Andrew Lee and Richard Musgrave.
- b. Proposed alterations and a two storey rear extension at 7 Saxton Lane, Saxton – permission has already been given for a rear extension flat roof and the applicant is now wishing to put on a pitched roof. The Parish Council had no objection
- c. Rose Dene – advice had been received that permission was granted. The Portakabin had been removed.

To decide upon action to be taken regarding Community Speed Watch Initiative

The Clerk would make additional copies of the relevant notice and look for volunteers; meanwhile she would contact the organisers of the Initiative to register the interest of the PC and its request to be accepted onto the scheme.

To Decide Upon Membership of Y.W.T.

It was decided to re-join. The subscription was £50.

To Consider a Public Consultation on Signage for Saxton

It was agreed to obtain some sample signs and pursue some suggested designs.
