To Receive Report on Request for Footpaths Reinstatement

Richard Bayston had contacted the Chair for the Parish Council's initial views over a proposed public right of way diversion and was asked for more detail. This item was tabled for the next meeting. The question of encroachment by Highways onto the grass verges both on Headwell Lane and Dam Lane was again raised, and the Chairman observed that the traffic was eroding the edges of the road. Cllr. Ms Marshall would investigate the footpaths previously on the roadside which were no longer there.
