Planning in the Parish

- a. Proposed demolition of existing bungalow and erection of 2 No. dwelling houses at Stonecroft Milner Lane, Saxton 8/67/76C/PA – revised application not yet received; the Clerk would chase
- b. Proposed erection of 2-storey front and side extensions and internal alterations at The Old Stables, Wakefield Road, Saxton – revised application. – no comment deadline as yet
- c. Application to vary conditions of approval to new detached house and garage at Pear Tree Farm, Main Street, Saxton – there had been no objection to the original application, but the proposed alterations not only increase the volume and footprint, but also change the materials from magnesian limestone to brick. The Clerk was instructed to write a letter of objection, incorporating the points made by members, and requesting that the variation be treated as a new application and be determined by the planning committee. District Councillor Richard Musgrave pointed out there was a training session with regard to planning and he would email information to the Clerk. It was noted that Cllr. Mr. Westmoreland, having declared his personal interest, abstained from both the discussion and the vote.
