

There is a floodlight situated in the middle of the church yard, by the Grade II cross, but hidden by brambles, and the Archdeacon agreed that the brambles could be cleared, though the holly tree also there should not be cut.

With regard to ownership of the electrical equipment it was established that the majority belongs to the church council, with the exception of the lamp halfway up the path to the church, which is on the PC system. Clarity was needed, to be followed by a formal agreement between the church and the Parish Council. The vicar will communicate with the Registrar, and get back to the PC Clerk, who will provide copies of the electrical layout for both the DAC and the PCC.
